

HUMAN FACTORS AND ERGONOMICS EDUCATION

If you would like to learn more about human factors and ergonomics (HFE) and how to analyse and develop innovative solutions for a wide range of problems and possibilities, you can advance your practice at AUT with our accredited postgraduate courses in HFE.

The HFE PG programme has been accredited by the Chartered Institute of Ergonomics and Human Factors (CIEHF), UK. The qualification is recognised by the Human Factors Association of New Zealand (HFESNZ) Professional Affairs Board (PAB) with respect to applications for professional membership.

What does it involve?

- You can enrol in individual courses* or work your way through the programme to qualify with PG Certificate, Diploma or Master's degree in health sciences (with focus on Human Factors and Ergonomics)
- Compulsory courses for the programme: Occupational Ergonomics* (RHAB801) in Semester 1 and Health Ergonomics* (RHAB811) in Semester 2
- Teaching methods: combination of in-person teaching at AUT (two 3 day teaching blocks for Occupational Ergonomics; a 3.5 day teaching block for Health Ergonomics) and self-directed learning.
- Logistics: you can complete the courses whilst working and living anywhere in NZ. You DO NOT have to move to Auckland!
